Members in the know, know -Elections in odd years are non-partisan. Not *all* non-partisan offices are up for election in 2025.

If more than two candidates are running for an office on your ballot, the *Feb. 18 primary* will apply to you. This will be at a local level (school boards, county supervisors, circuit courts, other local offices).

The two statewide races on the spring 2025 ballot are for a seat on the state Supreme Court and the state superintendent of public instruction. These races will be on everyone's ballot for the April 1 election.


